

Exercise physiologists are universally qualified allied health professionals equipped with the knowledge, skills and competencies to design, deliver and evaluate safe and effective exercise interventions.

There is strong evidence to support the health benefits of regular exercise (150 mins per week of moderate intensity cardiovascular exercise and 2-3 sessions per week of muscle strengthening exercises). If you need support and guidance to achieve these recommendations, we are here to help you by delivering an individualised exercise program to address your particular health concern.

Conditions include (but not limited to):

- Cancer
- Cardiovascular
- Respiratory/pulmonary
- Heart failure
- Diabetes
- Metabolic (including kidney disease)
- Neurological conditions
- Musculoskeletal conditions
- Osteoporosis and arthritis (OA/RA)

What the service includes:

- Initial assessment with an exercise physiologist
- Review with an exercise physiologist (as required/ specified)
- One-to-one exercise program
- Group sessions run by an exercise physiologist where eligible (Malvern campus)
- Assistance with home exercise program
- Assistance with transition to gym/ community recreation programs
